Join us for Wayne's Vigil to End Gun Violence Sunday, April 11, 2021, 3:30 p.m.
Beginning at Wayne United Methodist Church LEARN—PRAY—ACT

The group will march in procession along Lancaster Avenue in the center of Wayne, stopping at Central Baptist Church, Wayne Presbyterian Church, and St. Mary's Episcopal Church for further brief remembrances. Each participant is

urged to bring a homemade sign expressing a point of advocacy with respect to ending gun violence that is of particular import to him/her. The vigil will end where it began, at Wayne United Methodist Church, with an opportunity to write or sign letters urging state legislators to enact effective gun laws to stop the killing. Note that **all** events will be outdoors, and face masks will be required.
