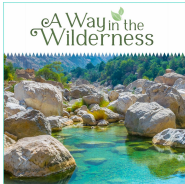

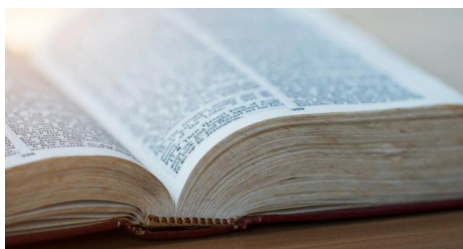
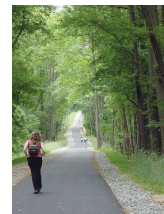


New and "Newish" Member Class: Sunday, Oct. 17 from 1-4 p.m. - Fireside Rm.
