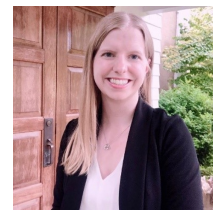


Giving by text

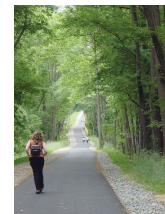
