


We welcome our new Associate Director of Music, Dr. Kirsten Santos Rutschman. She begins her ministry with us this Sunday, January 30.

Kirsten will be directing the children's choirs, the bell choirs, and the chamber orchestra. An organist, pianist and Swedish fiddler, Kirsten holds degrees in musicology (Ph.D., M.A.) from Duke University and in German Studies (B.A.) from Stanford University. In addition, she has studied and completed Fulbright-supported research in Sweden.

Before coming to Wayne, Kirsten was Organist/Accompanist at First Presbyterian Church of St. Louis for almost four years. During that time, she taught music theory and related courses at Saint Louis University, Webster University, and Southern Illinois

University, Edwardsville, and she served on the Executive Committee of the St. Louis Chapter of the American Guild of Organists. Kirsten has also presented a research paper at the National Convention of the AGO (Boston, 2014).
