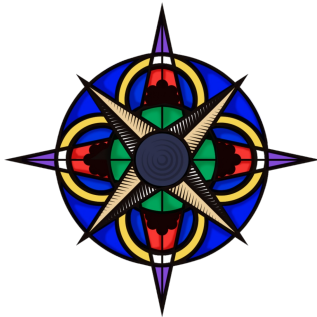

Miller is an installed pastor, the congregation must vote to “dissolve” his pastoral relationship with the church. Therefore, the Session is calling a congregational meeting for Sunday, October 23 after the 9:30 a.m. worship service to vote to approve Richard's request. After the meeting, please join us in the chapel for a celebration of Richard's ministry.

Please note: On October 23, all 9:30 a.m. Sunday School and Adult Ed programs will meet as regularly scheduled, however, there will be no 11:00 a.m. worship service. The 9:30 a.m. service will be live streamed and recorded, but the congregational meeting will not. Please plan to attend the meeting in person to participate in this important vote.

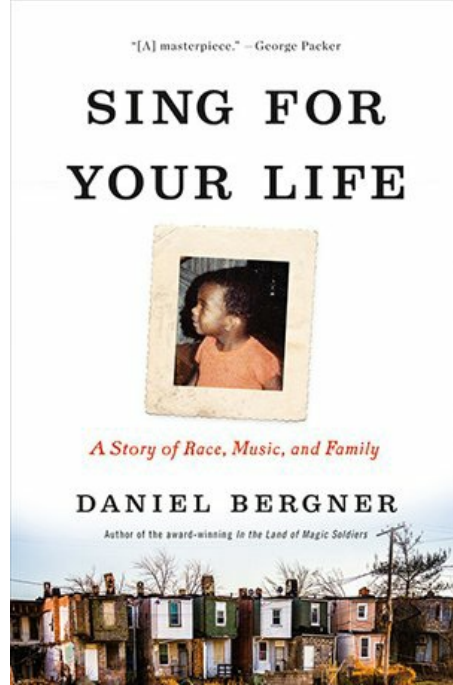
