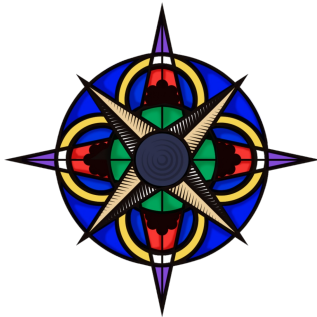

### **An Evening with Rev. Jimmie Hawkins**

It is a great honor and opportunity for us to welcome to our meeting on Tuesday, October 25 at 7:30 p.m. by Zoom the Rev. Jimmie Hawkins Executive Director of the PCUSA Office of Public Witness in Washington DC.

Rev. Hawkins will review what he understands as the call of God to our denomination to maintain an office such as his to implement actions of the General Assembly. He will give an overview of the Committee's role and also will also mention how he sees the work of governmental advocacy by individual members of churches as a form of spiritual discipline. Rev. Hawkins will then take as an important example of this work its advocacy for legislation to expand election voting rights and also its work opposing legislation which would restrict such rights or distort election systems. He sees this as advocating for the disenfranchised and those without a voice which is part of the call of Christ. And finally, Rev. Hawkins will answer questions and lead discussion on comments directly related to his talk. The entire program is scheduled to end after 80 minutes. Register [here](#).

### **Dinner and A Movie**

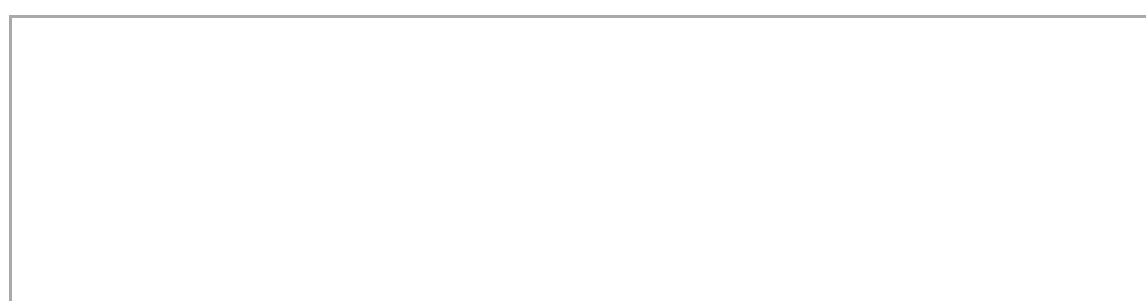

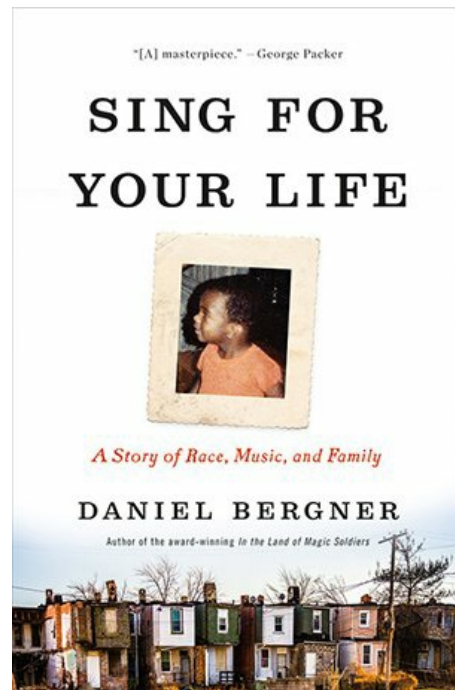
