



#### Meet Our New Bridge Associate Pastor - Liz Wagner

At a called meeting on Sunday December 11, the Session unanimously voted to hire Rev. Liz Wagner to serve as a bridge associate pastor. (Bridge is the presbytery language for a temporary pastor who is hired by the Session). Liz currently serves as our Director of Finance, and she is also ordained as a Minister of the Word and Sacrament in the Presbyterian Church (USA). Over the next few weeks, she will be transitioning out of that role and into a full-time pastoral role, overseeing pastoral care, Faith in



Action (Mission), and the Board of Deacons. Liz will officially begin her duties as an associate pastor on Sunday January 8, when she will preach at both services, and will serve as one of our pastors until at least December 31, 2023. Please plan to attend worship and Coffee Hour Fellowship on January 8 to warmly welcome Liz to her new role.

#### **Blood Drive**




