

HERE'S WHERE WE ARE... AN UPDATE FROM THE STEERING COMMITTEE (FOR THE PARKING LOT PROPOSAL)

During May, the Steering Committee met with various church administrators, committee members and members with professional expertise to better understand:

- The Church's financial history, current reality, and future projections.
- The Church's history with storm water damage concerns and costs, Township initiatives, and any options explored.
- The current state of the Church's physical plant, roof, and upcoming capital expenditures.

We held five Congregational Listening Sessions during the Month of June. These meetings provided the opportunity for church members to share their concerns, raise questions, and voice comments on a wide variety of topics related to both the "Proposal," the current mission, and the future vitality of Wayne Presbyterian Church.

We plan to hold two additional Listening Sessions in July – on *Sunday, July 10, and July 17 at 11:30 AM*. Keep your eyes on the WPC website, News & Views, WPC Social Media sites for all updates, communications, or meeting registrations related to the Steering Committee. It is our hope that these Listening Sessions begin to build trust and understanding.

The Steering Committee is currently in a period of information gathering. After we process and discern the information collected, the committee will submit a recommendation to the Session this September, outlining options to move forward.


Have you ever thought about ringing handbells? If you've ever played an instrument at any point in your life, or you have ever sung, or you can count to the number 4, handbells might be for you!

"Highclimbers", a well-respected local steeplejack firm, has been hired to restore our Chapel steeple. They will erect scaffolding, perform needed repairs, and then paint the steeple starting June 24 and completing by July 30, weather permitting. A couple years ago, the Property Committee hired a professional drone company to take pictures of what is not apparent to our eyes, and it became apparent the steeple needs repair and paint. This restoration work will enhance our restored 1870 Chapel as well as remain a historic feature in the Wayne community.
